### Day by Day Itinerary

October 13 Day 1: Depart USA: Today we board our flights to Italy with beverages and snacks served aloft.

October 14 Day 2: Arrive Venice: Upon arrival in Venice, we transfer to our hotel near Venice for overnight.

Overnight: Venice Area (Mestre)

October 15 Day 3: Venice: St. Mark's Square/Embark Cruise: After breakfast, we take our private boat to San Marco's Square and explore Venice, nicknamed "la Serenissima." We begin with a guided walking tour of St. Mark's Square, one of the largest open spaces in Venice. We visit two of its landmark buildings, the Basilica of San Marco and the Bridge of Sighs. Afterwards, we transfer to the cruise port to embark on our cruise.

October 16 Day 4: Koper, Slovenia: Your journey commences with a visit to the remarkable Predjama Castle, an architectural marvel perched on a 123-meter-high cliff. Overnight: Cruise Ship (Breakfast, Dinner)

Here you will have Mass before traveling down to the ancient city where you can walk the marble roads rutted by wheels of countless chariots and pass the ruins of architectural masterpieces. It is here that St. Paul preached to the Ephesians, and where he was arrested and cast out of the city.

Overnight: Cruise Ship (Breakfast, Dinner)


October 24 Day 12: Disembark Istanbul: We disembark in Istanbul today and visit the Grand Bazaar. The Grand Bazaar is an amazing place - literally a maze of streets. It is one of the largest undercover bazaars in the world and is even divided into areas like the leather section or the rug section.

October 25 Day 13: Istanbul: Sultanahmet, Topkapi Palace, St. Sofia, Hippodrome: This morning we head to the Sultanahmet district. This World Heritage-listed district is crammed with historic buildings and atmosphere to keep you enthralled for days. Full-day visits to the Topkapi Palace; overlooking the Sea of Marmara and containing numerous chambers, courtyards, and royal treasures; the Sultan Ahmed (Blue) Mosque, with its six minarets and thousands of blue tiles; and the historic Hagia Sophia, now a museum, converted to a mosque from a Christian Basilica after the fall of Constantinople in 1453. Next, we see the Hippodrome and the Obelisk brought from Egypt.

October 26 Day 14: Return Flights Home: Today we board our return flights home with memories and keepsakes that will last a lifetime.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.
