Day by Day Itinerary

19 de octubre Día 1: Salida de EE. UU.: Vuelo a Tel Aviv: Salida para sus vuelos a Tel Aviv. Cena a bordo, relájate y anticipa tu llegada al día siguiente.

20 de octubre Día 2: Tel Aviv: Llegada a Tierra Santa: Nos recibirá a nuestra llegada el representante de Holy Land Travel Center quien nos acompañará durante toda la peregrinación. Luego nos trasladaremos a nuestro hotel para una cena de bienvenida y alojamiento.

Durante la noche: Belén (D)

21 de octubre Día 3: Belén/Ein Karem: Visitación de María y lugar de nacimiento de Jesús: En nuestro primer día en Tierra Santa, presentamos una descripción general para comprender mejor su geografía y algunos de los sitios clave que rodean el área y lo que la convierte en un área única para las tres religiones principales: el judaísmo, el cristianismo y el islam. Luego nos dirigimos al pueblo de Ein Karem, lugar de nacimiento de San Juan Bautista y a la Iglesia de la Visitación, donde la Santísima Virgen María visitó a su prima Isabel y proclamó el "Magnificat". Iglesia de la Natividad en Belén que se encuentra en el lugar donde nació Jesús. Regresamos a nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

22 de octubre Día 4: Belén: Misión Mañana Beit Sahour: Nos dirigimos a el Campo de los Pastores donde los ángeles anunciaron el nacimiento de Jesús. Luego visitamos el Campo de Booz, que es recordado como una de las declaraciones de devoción más célebres del Antiguo Testamento. Nos trasladaremos a nuestro hotel para pasar tiempo libre, cena y alojamiento.

Almuerzo: Sahara Hotel Beit Sahour.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Almuerzo, Cena)

23 de octubre Día 5: Belén: Visita y degustación del monasterio y bodega de Cremisan.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

24 de octubre Día 6: Cesarea/ Haifa/ Nazaret: Después del desayuno, nos dirigimos a Cesarea junto al mar para visitar los restos de los cruzados romanos antes de continuar hacia Haifa. Al llegar a Haifa, visitaremos Stella Maris, un monasterio carmelita con la Virgen del Monte Carmelo. A continuación, nos detenemos en los Jardines Bahá'ís, que incluyen una escalera de diecinueve terrazas que se extiende hasta la ladera norte del Monte Carmelo. Visitamos la Basílica de la Anunciación donde celebraremos la Misa. Luego continuamos hacia nuestro hotel en Nazaret.

Durante la noche: Nazaret (Desayuno, Cena) *

25 de octubre Día 7: Tiberíades: El Ministerio de Cristo en Galilea/Pueblo de Magdala: Hoy haremos un paseo en barco por el Mar de Galilea hasta Capernaum para ver la sinagoga y la casa de San Pedro, una visita al Monte de las Bienaventuranzas donde se pronunció el Sermón de la Montaña, a Tabgha para ver el espléndido mosaico sobre el milagro de los panes y los peces, y a la cercana Iglesia del Primado de Pedro, donde a Pedro le dijeron: "Apacienta mis corderos, alimenta mis ovejas". Habrá una Misa inolvidable cerca de las orillas del Mar de Galilea en el Primado o Monte de las Bienaventuranzas. A continuación, nos dirigimos al pueblo de Magdala, donde visitaremos la iglesia recién construida y las ruinas recién excavadas.

Durante la noche: Nazaret (Desayuno, Cena)

26 de octubre Día 8: Cana/Monte Tabor: Después del desayuno, nos dirigimos a Caná, donde las parejas tendrán la oportunidad de renovar sus votos matrimoniales. A continuación, disfrutamos de una visita a la carpintería de Joseph. Esta tarde nos dirigiremos al Monte Tabor, el lugar de la Transfiguración. Continuación hacia Belén.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

27 de octubre Día 9: Monte de los Olivos/Monte Sión: La Pasión de las Últimas Horas de Jesús: Comenzamos nuestro día con una visita al Monte de los Olivos donde Jesús oró, continuamos hacia la iglesia de Pater Noster donde Jesús enseñó a los discípulos el Padrenuestro. A continuación, recorremos el Camino del Domingo de Ramos, parando en Dominus Flevit, donde Jesús lloró sobre Jerusalén. Luego a Getsemaní, la Roca de la Agonía donde Jesús hizo su última oración antes de su arresto. A continuación, nos dirigimos al Monte Sión, visitando la cueva de la Asunción (Abadía de la Dormición) de María al cielo. Visitamos la sala de la Última Cena y la Iglesia de San Pedro Gallicantu, donde Pedro negó a Jesús tres veces. Terminamos nuestro día visitando el Muro de las Lamentaciones antes de continuar hacia nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

28 de octubre Día 10: Ciudad Vieja de Jerusalén: Muro de las Lamentaciones y Muro Occidental del Monte del Templo. Incluye Parque Arqueológico y recorrido subterráneo. Terminamos el día visitando el Muro de las Lamentaciones antes de continuar hacia nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

29 de octubre Día 11: Ciudad Vieja de Jerusalén: El Vía Crucis: Después del desayuno nos dirigimos a Jerusalén y comenzamos nuestra visita con la Iglesia de Santa Ana (el lugar tradicional de nacimiento de la Virgen María). Continúe viendo a las Hermanas de Sión, Ecco Homo, donde Pilato proclamó: "He aquí el hombre". A continuación, volvemos sobre los últimos pasos de Jesús mientras caminamos por la Vía Dolorosa, a través de los mercados de la Ciudad Vieja rezando el Vía Crucis en cada santuario de la estación, reflexionamos sobre la grandeza de Su sacrificio. Finalmente llegamos a la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro para Misa. Tiempo libre en la Ciudad Vieja de Jerusalén para oraciones. Cena y alojamiento en nuestro hotel.

Durante la noche: Belén (Desayuno, Cena)

30 de octubre Día 12: Betania/ Jericó: El desierto: Comenzamos nuestro día con una visita a Betania donde Jesús resucitó a Lázaro de entre los muertos. El desierto al este de Jerusalén es rico en tradición cristiana. En la ciudad oasis de Jericó, visite las excavaciones de la ciudad más antigua del mundo y vea el Monte Tentación desde un teleférico que sube la montaña. En el camino de regreso, tendrá tiempo para nadar (¡o más bien flotar!) en las aguas ricas en minerales del Mar Muerto, famosas por sus propiedades curativas. Luego visitamos el río Jordán para recordar el bautismo de nuestro Señor.

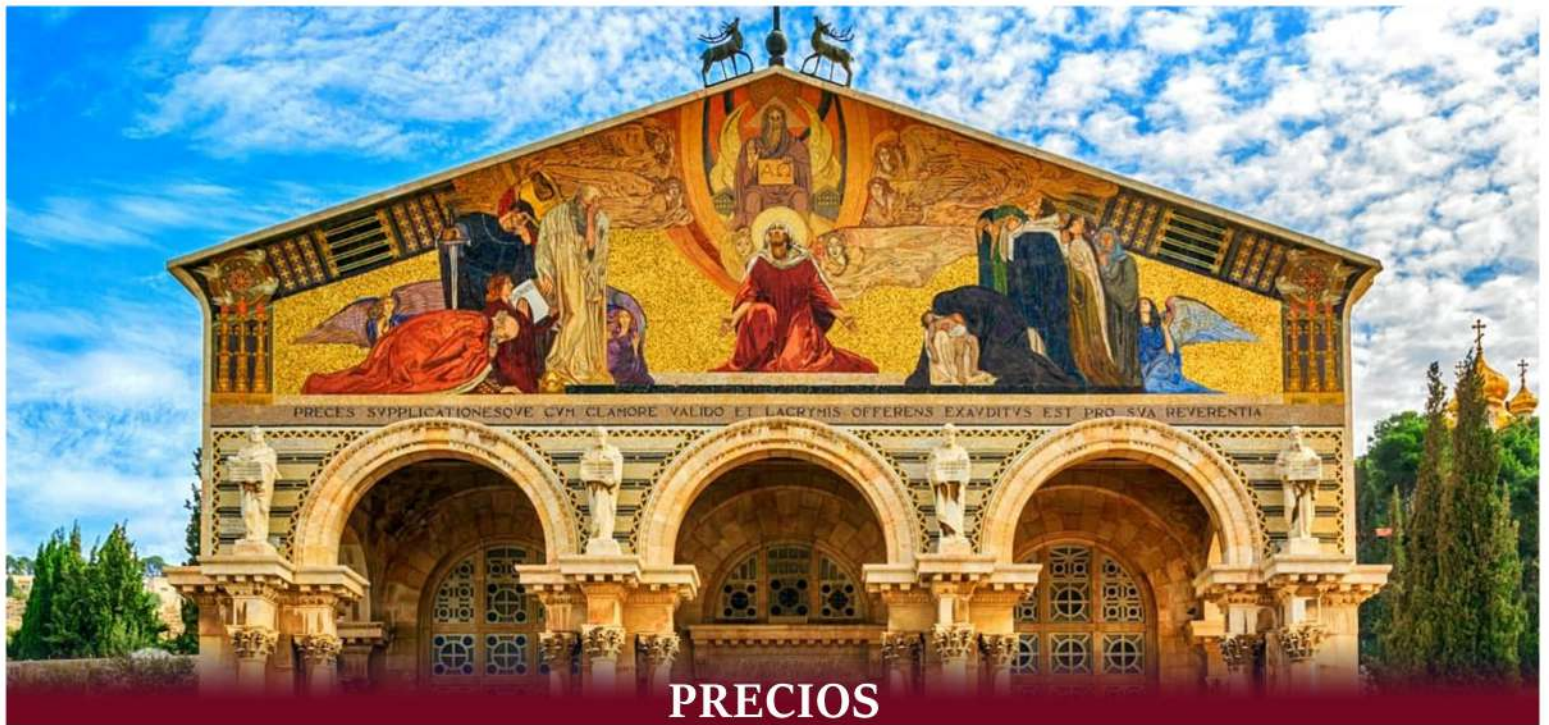

Terms & Conditions

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Holy Land Travel Center shall be referred to as HLTC within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by HLTC. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. HLTC reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after HLTC receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail., HLTC will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

- 1) Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.
- 2) From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.
- 3) From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.
- 4) From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you chose to purchase outside of the time sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. HLTC is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. HLTC (Holy Land Travel Company) holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each: Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. HLTC cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When HLTC disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline, any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions."

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations.

PRICES: All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at time of quotation and based on minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if group does not reach minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extra beyond standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

VISA FOR EUROPE - ETIAS

-Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe.

- This applies to all travelers, and all ages.

- Fee approx. \$9. Per Person
