Day by Day Itinerary

8 de septiembre, Día 1: Salida hacia Roma: Nuestra peregrinación espiritual comienza cuando abordamos nuestro vuelo transatlántico hacia Roma, con comidas y bebidas servidas durante el vuelo.

9 de septiembre, Día 2: Llegada a Roma: Bienvenidos a Roma, también conocida como "La Ciudad Eterna." Al llegar al aeropuerto de Roma, recogeremos nuestro equipaje en la zona de reclamo de equipaje, donde seremos recibidos por nuestro representante de Holy Land Travel Center. Nos dirigimos al autobús y viajamos hacia la Basílica de San Pablo Extramuros, donde visitaremos nuestra primera gran basílica y la primera Puerta Santa de nuestra peregrinación del Año Jubilar. Celebramos la Misa aquí y realizamos un recorrido por la basílica antes de trasladarnos a nuestro hotel para la cena y el alojamiento. Alojamiento: Roma (Cena*)

10 de septiembre, Día 3: Roma: Audiencia Papal - Basílica de San Juan de Letrán - Escalera Santa - Basílica de Santa María la Mayor: Esta mañana asistimos a la Audiencia Papal en la Plaza de San Pedro o en el Aula de las Audiencias. La Audiencia es celebrada cada miércoles por Su Santidad, el Papa Francisco (dependiendo del calendario papal). Por la tarde, visitamos la más antigua de las cuatro basílicas mayores de Roma, la Archibasílica de San Juan de Letrán, la iglesia catedral y sede del Obispo de Roma. Cruzamos la calle para ver los mismos escalones que conducen al pretorio de Poncio Pilato en Jerusalén, que Jesús subió en su camino al juicio durante su Pasión. La Misa será celebrada por nuestro sacerdote en la Basílica de Santa María la Mayor, dedicada a nuestra Madre Santísima. Cena y alojamiento. Alojamiento: Roma (Desayuno, Cena)

11 de septiembre, Día 4: Basílica de San Pedro - Museo Vaticano - Basílica de San Pablo Extramuros - Catacumbas: Hoy realizamos un recorrido por el Museo Vaticano donde podemos ver la Galería de Tapices, las Salas de Rafael y la Capilla Sixtina. Despues, entramos en la Basílica de San Pedro, construida sobre el sitio donde fue martirizado San Pedro. Aquí tendremos la oportunidad de ver la escultura de la Piedad de Miguel Ángel y rezar en las tumbas del Papa Benedicto XVI y San Juan Pablo II. Por la tarde, realizamos un recorrido a pie por Roma, visitando lugares como la Fontana de Trevi, pasamos cerca del Coliseo, el Panteón y el Foro Romano.

Alojamiento: Roma (Desayuno, Cena)

12 de septiembre, Día 5: Roma - Monte Cassino - San Giovanni Rotondo: Esta mañana abordamos el autobús y disfrutamos del recorrido escénico hacia la Abadía de Monte Cassino, el monasterio principal de la Orden Benedictina, fundado por San Benito alrededor del 530 d.C. Continuamos hacia San Giovanni Rotondo, donde San Pío de Pietrelcina (San Padre Pío) vivió durante muchas décadas y donde miles de personas han llegado para estar más cerca de este gran santo y de Nuestro Señor. Cena y alojamiento en San Giovanni Rotondo.

Alojamiento: San Giovanni Rotondo (Desayuno, Cena)

13 de septiembre, Día 6: San Giovanni Rotondo - Monte Sant' Angelo: Visitamos la Antigua Iglesia de Nuestra Señora de la Gracia y vemos el confesionario donde San Pío pasó innumerables horas escuchando confesiones. Luego, abordamos el autobús y viajamos a lo largo de la hermosa Península del Gargano hasta la Gruta de San Miguel Arcángel. Regresamos para la cena y alojamiento en San Giovanni Rotondo. *Procesión de las velas -

Entre mayo y octubre, participamos en la procesión semanal de las velas en el Santuario de San Pío después de la cena, a las 9:00 pm.

Alojamiento: San Giovanni Rotondo (Desayuno, Cena)

14 de septiembre, Día 7: San Giovanni Rotondo - Lanciano - Loreto - Asís: Despues del desayuno, salimos hacia Asís. En el camino, hacemos una parada en Lanciano para una Misa privada en la Iglesia de San Longino, el sitio de un Milagro Eucarístico ocurrido en el siglo VIII. En ese momento, había un monje basiliano que dudaba de la Creencia en la Real Presencia en la Eucaristía. Durante la Misa, el monje, con duda en su voz, dijo las palabras de consagración, y el pan y el vino se transformaron en carne y sangre físicas. Luego partimos hacia el santuario mariano de Loreto para visitar la Santa Casa de Nazaret y la hermosa Madonna de Loreto. La tradición sostiene que esta es la casa en la que María rezó el Magníficat por primera vez, en la que Jesús creció hasta la adultez y en la que vivió la Sagrada Familia, antes de ser transportada en varias ocasiones por ángeles a su ubicación actual. Terminamos el día en Asís, ciudad natal de San Francisco y Santa Clara, con cena y alojamiento en el hotel.


Alojamiento: Asís (Desayuno, Cena)

15 de septiembre, Día 8: Asís: Visitamos la Basílica de San Francisco, donde veremos la tumba de San Francisco y tendremos la oportunidad de admirar una serie de frescos que representan su vida, junto con algunas de las posesiones del santo. Luego, visitamos el Santuario Della Spogliazione, donde se encuentra la tumba del Beato Carlo Acutis, el primer milenario en ser declarado Beato. Continuamos el recorrido caminando por este pintoresco pueblo, donde San Francisco y Santa Clara respondieron al llamado de Dios para reconstruir su iglesia. Tendremos tiempo libre para oración adicional, compras y almuerzo. Despues del almuerzo, abordamos el autobús, que nos llevará fuera de los muros de Asís, hasta la Basílica de Santa María de los Ángeles. Esta basílica está compuesta por dos estructuras, ambas visitaremos. La primera es la "Porziuncola" y la segunda es la "Capilla del Tránsito," el lugar donde murió San Francisco. Regresamos al hotel para la cena y una noche de descanso. Alojamiento: Asís (Desayuno, Cena)

16 de septiembre, Día 9: Asís - Orvieto - Bolsena - Roma: Esta mañana viajamos a través de las hermosas montañas de Umbría hacia Orvieto. Esta increíble ciudad está ubicada sobre una formación rocosa volcánica. Aquí visitamos una de las catedrales más hermosas y renombradas de Italia. Debido a su ubicación estratégica, su historia cristiana comenzó oficialmente en el año 1004, pero Orvieto fue construida sobre túneles de cavernas de la época etrusca que datan de hace 2,500 años, los cuales algunos historiadores creen que los cristianos utilizaron para celebrar la Misa cuando el cristianismo estaba prohibido. Luego, visitamos el cercano pueblo de Bolsena y la catedral que alberga el corporal del Milagro de la Eucaristía, ocurrido en 1262. Aquí celebramos la Misa. Traslado a Roma para la cena y alojamiento.

17 de septiembre, Día 10: Vuelos de regreso a casa: Hoy abordamos nuestros vuelos de regreso a casa con recuerdos y souvenirs que durarán toda la vida.

Terms & Conditions

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

VOUCHERS: Travel vouchers issued by PAX VIA may be applied to a new trip after the initial deposit has been made. To ensure proper processing, all vouchers must be applied no later than **150 days prior to the new trip's departure date**. Vouchers cannot be used to cover the initial deposit, nor can they be applied retroactively to previously booked trips. Failure to apply a voucher within the specified timeframe will result in forfeiture of its use for that particular trip. All voucher applications are subject to verification and approval by PAX VIA.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this

adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

PASSPORTS: Passports are required to travel with Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. A Passport Card is not useful for International Air Travel. Attempting to use this instead of a Passport Book will result in a denial of boarding by the airlines and entry by the legal authorities.

VISA FOR EUROPE – ETIAS -Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe. – This applies to all travelers, and all ages. – Fee approx. \$9 per person – The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
