## Day by Day Itinerary

**March 9 Day 1: Depart USA:** Today we board our overnight flights to Madrid with meals and beverages served aloft.

**March 10 Day 2: Arrive Madrid:** Upon arrival in Spain's vibrant capital, we are met by our local representative and transferred to our hotel. Depending on arrival time, we may enjoy a brief orientation drive or a gentle stroll through the charming streets of old Madrid, including the iconic Plaza Mayor. In the evening, we gather for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight:** Madrid (Dinner)

**March 11 Day 3: Art, Faith, and the Heart of Madrid:** Begin your day at the Prado Museum, home to sacred masterpieces by Velázquez, Goya, and El Greco. Explore the deep religious symbolism woven throughout these iconic works. Then visit Almudena Cathedral, a striking neo-Gothic church dedicated to Our Lady of Almudena, where you may celebrate or attend Mass. In the afternoon, enjoy free time in Plaza Mayor—Madrid's most historic square—perfect for shopping, relaxing, or enjoying tapas in an open-air café. Let the art, architecture, and spirit of Madrid enrich your journey.

**Overnight:** Madrid (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 12 Day 4: Toledo – The Spiritual Heart of Spain:** Today we enjoy a day trip to the ancient city of Toledo, known as the “City of Three Cultures.” We begin with a visit to the magnificent Toledo Cathedral and then explore the Jewish Quarter and the historic Synagogue of El Transito. Enjoy time to browse local shops before we return to Madrid.

**Overnight:** Madrid (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 13 Day 5: Travel to Valencia via La Mancha:** This morning we bid farewell to Madrid and journey through the famous La Mancha countryside, where windmills and medieval villages recall the tale of Don Quixote. Along the way, we enjoy a scenic rest stop before arriving in the Mediterranean city of Valencia.

**Overnight:** Valencia (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 14 Day 6: Valencia – Faith & Foundations:** This morning we begin with a guided visit to the Cathedral of Valencia, where tradition holds the Holy Grail is kept. We continue to the Basilica of Our Lady of the Forsaken, one of the city's most beloved religious sites. Then we stroll through the Plaza de la Virgen and visit the nearby Archaeological Museum, showcasing Roman and Visigothic foundations beneath the city. After a group lunch, enjoy a relaxed afternoon with the option to explore local cafés or return to the hotel.

**Overnight:** Valencia (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 15 Day 7: Valencia – Markets & Modernism:** Today we focus on Valencia's rich civic and cultural history. Begin with a visit to the Central Market, one of the largest and most beautiful in Europe. From there, tour the Lonja de la Seda (Silk Exchange), a UNESCO World Heritage Site, followed by a walk past the Palau de la Generalitat. We finish the morning with a visit to the Iglesia de San Nicolás, often called the “Sistine Chapel of Valencia” for its spectacular ceiling frescoes. The afternoon is free for optional visits to the City of Arts and Sciences or shopping in the old town.

**Overnight:** Valencia (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 16 Day 8: Alicante to Granada:** This morning we travel south along the coast to the city of Alicante, where we visit the Basilica of Santa Maria, the oldest active church in the city. After celebrating Mass, we continue through the scenic countryside to the historic city of Granada.

**Overnight:** Granada (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 17 Day 9: Granada – Alhambra & Generalife Gardens:** Today we visit one of Spain's most breathtaking sites: the Alhambra. This Moorish palace-fortress complex features intricate architecture, fountains, and arabesque gardens. We also explore the nearby Generalife, the royal summer residence. The afternoon is free for shopping or personal sightseeing.

**Overnight:** Granada (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 18 Day 10: Córdoba – Mosque-Cathedral & Jewish Quarter:** Today we travel to Córdoba, a city of incredible religious and historical significance. We visit the grand Mosque-Cathedral (Mezquita), one of the greatest monuments of Islamic and Christian Spain, and stroll through the charming Jewish Quarter. We continue on to Seville for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight:** Seville (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 19 Day 11: Gibraltar – The Rock & the Strait:** This morning we travel south to Gibraltar, the British territory perched on the edge of Europe. We take a guided tour of the iconic Rock of Gibraltar, with panoramic views of the Mediterranean and even Morocco on a clear day. Visit St. Michael's Cave, meet the famous Barbary macaques, and stop for Mass at the Cathedral of St. Mary the Crowned. Enjoy free time in the main square before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**Overnight:** Seville (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 20 Day 12: Seville – Catholic Heritage & Colorful Culture:** Begin with morning Mass at a historic local church. Then, enjoy a panoramic tour featuring the Gold Tower, Plaza de España, and Maria Luisa Park. We visit the Seville Cathedral, housing the tomb of Christopher Columbus, and explore the charming Santa Cruz Quarter with its narrow alleys and hidden courtyards. The afternoon is at leisure.

**Overnight:** Seville (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 21 Day 13: Ronda & Arcos de la Frontera:** Today we take a day trip through the hills of Andalusia to visit Ronda, famous for its dramatic cliffs and iconic bridge. We stroll through the old town and enjoy time in the peaceful Casa Don Bosco gardens. Then, continue to Arcos de la Frontera, one of Spain's famed white villages, where we explore its castle and admire sweeping views before returning to Seville.

**Overnight:** Seville (Breakfast, Dinner)

**March 22 Day 14: Return Flights Home:** This morning we board our return flights home, filled with memories of the history, beauty, and blessings we've experienced through Spain.

# **Terms & Conditions**

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

**DOCUMENTS:** US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

**REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT:** Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

**INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS:** Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

**PAYMENT:** Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

**BOUNCED CHECKS:** Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

**DISPUTED PAYMENTS:** In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

**TRAVEL PROTECTION:** Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. **MEDICAL CONDITION:** We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

**LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS:** By private deluxe motor coach.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

**MOBILE APP:** Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

**MEALS:** Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

**TIPPING:** Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

**AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH:** Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot

guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

**SEAT ASSIGNMENT:** THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

**BAGGAGE:** Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

**VISAS:** When and if a visa or visa waiver is required, it is the passenger's responsibility to obtain one. **PASSPORTS:** Passports are required to travel with Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. A Passport Card is not useful for International Air Travel. Attempting to use this instead of a Passport Book will result in a denial of boarding by the airlines and entry by the legal authorities.

**VISA FOR EUROPE – ETIAS** -Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe. – This applies to all travelers, and all ages. – Fee approx. \$9 per person – The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
