Day by Day Itinerary

July 27 Day 1: Depart USA: Today begins your international overnight flight to Lisbon, Portugal. Relax and enjoy as you embark on your spiritual journey. Embrace the excitement ahead!

July 28 Day 2: Arrive Lisbon: Santarem - Fatima: Upon arriving in Lisbon, you will meet your Tour Escort who will accompany you throughout your pilgrimage. Our first stop is Santarem, where we visit the historic Church of St. Stephen, known for its 8th-century eucharistic miracle. After this, we will head to Fatima for hotel check-in, followed by a lovely dinner and a restful overnight stay in preparation for the next leg of your pilgrimage.

Overnight: Fatima (Dinner*)

July 29 Day 3: Fatima: Chapel of Apparitions - Stations of the Cross: We begin with a solemn Mass at the Chapel of Apparitions, then visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Fatima to learn about Saints Francisco and Jacinta Marto. Next, we explore Aljustrel, the shepherd children's upbringing, and Valinhos, another significant apparition site. We conclude with reflection at the Stations of the Cross along the Via Sacra, marking the first apparition, followed by dinner and an overnight stay at our hotel.

Overnight: Fatima (Breakfast, Dinner)

July 30 Day 4: Fatima: Porto - Santiago de Compostela: After breakfast at your hotel, we start our 2-hour journey to Porto. Located along the Douro River estuary, Porto is one of the oldest European centers. Porto is famous for its port wine, a major international export. The port wine derived its name from the City of Porto. When in Porto, we visit the Monument Church of St. Francis, celebrate Holy Mass at Our Lady of the Clergy, and visit the historic Church of Gold. After a late lunch, we continue to Santiago de Compostela for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)

July 31 Day 5: Santiago de Compostela: After breakfast, we will explore Santiago de Compostela, famous for its historical significance. The tour includes a visit to the magnificent Cathedral, the sacred Tomb of St. James, and the beautiful Churches of San Francisco and Santa Clara, as well as the impressive Bell Tower. After a day of discovery, we'll return to our hotel for dinner and an overnight stay.

Overnight: Santiago de Compostela (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 1 Day 6: Santiago De Compostela: Santo Toribio De Liébana - Garabandal: After breakfast, we depart Santiago de Compostela and journey toward the Cantabria region. Our first stop will be Santo Toribio de Liébana, one of the most important pilgrimage sites in Spain and home to the Lignum Crucis, believed to be the largest remaining fragment of the True Cross. We will have time for prayers and reflection at the monastery. We then continue to the village of Garabandal, known for the Marian apparitions of the 1960s. Here, we will visit key sites associated with the apparitions and spend time in prayer before continuing to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Overnight: Santander (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 2 Day 7: Bilbao: Loyola - Lourdes: This morning we depart Santander and travel toward the Basque Country. Our first stop will be in Bilbao, where we visit Bilbao Cathedral, dedicated to St. James and an important religious landmark of the city. We will also view the iconic Guggenheim Museum from the exterior, a symbol of modern Bilbao. Continuing onward, we arrive in Loyola, the birthplace of St. Ignatius

and founder of the Jesuit Order. We visit the Basilica of Loyola and learn about the life and conversion of St. Ignatius. After time for prayer, we continue our journey into France, arriving in Lourdes for hotel check-in and dinner. In the evening, pilgrims may choose to participate in the candlelight procession.

Overnight: Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 3 Day 8: Lourdes: After breakfast, join a guided tour of Lourdes, including St. Bernadette's house, the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, and the Miraculous Spring known for its healing claims. Visit the XII-century Castle for panoramic views and insight into the town's medieval history. Enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure. Dinner and overnight accommodations are included at your hotel.

Overnight: Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 4 Day 9: Lourdes: Today is a free day in Lourdes for your own personal activities.

Overnight: Lourdes (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 5 Day 10: Flights to Medjugorje: Make your way to your local airport where you will board your flight. Upon arrival collect your luggage in the baggage claim area and continue to the arrival's hall where you will be greeted by your tour guide and driver, who will take you on the 2 1/2-hour drive to the village of Medjugorje. Enjoy dinner before retiring for the evening.

Overnight: Medjugorje (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 6 Day 11: Medjugorje: Experience the beauty and peace of this simple village. During your stay in Medjugorje you will have the opportunity to share faith with pilgrims from all over the world. Here are some of the activities we'll be sharing with our fellow pilgrims: Each morning at 10am we assemble at St James Church for the English-language Mass (Feast days and Sundays English Mass is at Noon). Follow the path up Apparition Hill where the visionaries first encountered Our Lady. Touch and pray before the cross that commemorates the spot where Mary first appeared to the visionaries. Each evening, we will join the villagers and pilgrims in praying the rosary. The Apparition usually takes place at 5:40 PM (20 minutes till 6:00 PM). Once Daylight Saving Time ends, the time will shift to 6:40 PM. Each evening there is the Blessing of the Sick and a blessing of any religious items you have with you.

Overnight: Medjugorje (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 7 Day 12: Medjugorje: This morning, our guide will arrange meetings with the visionaries at their own homes provided that they are in Medjugorje during your trip and pending their availability. We will have the opportunity to climb Krizevac Mountain, where in 1933 the villagers built a 30' high cross on the anniversary of Jesus' crucifixion. Visit and pray at "Blue Cross", which is a place of great healings and graces- a very special place at the base of Apparition Hill.

Overnight: Medjugorje (Breakfast, Dinner)

August 8 Day 13: Return Home: This morning we transfer to the airport for our return flights home, carrying with us unforgettable memories and graces from our pilgrimage.

Terms & Conditions

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot

guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

VISAS: When and if a visa or visa waiver is required, it is the passenger's responsibility to obtain one. PVTT, owner, agent, or employees cannot be held liable for clients not having proper passports, visa, visa waiver, or other travel documents. Cancellations or changes to schedule due to a lack of appropriate documents will incur usual penalties.

PASSPORTS: Passports are required to travel with Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. A Passport Card is not useful for International Air Travel. Attempting to use this instead of a Passport Book will result in a denial of boarding by the airlines and entry by the legal authorities.

By registering for the tour, you consent to photographs taken of you during your participation in the tour and to the publication of the photographs by the Operator for advertising, promotional, and marketing purposes. VISA FOR EUROPE – ETIAS -Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe. – This applies to all travelers, and all ages. – Fee approx. \$9 per person – The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
