Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1: Flights to Alaska: Today we take our flights to Anchorage, Alaska. Upon arrival, meet your private motor coach and transfer to Whittier, traveling through scenic Alaskan landscapes along the way. Upon arrival in Whittier, check in to your hotel.

Overnight: Whittier

Day 2: Whittier: City Tour & Cruise Embarkation: After breakfast, enjoy a guided city tour of Whittier. Learn about the town's unique history, originally built as a military port during World War II, and see its picturesque harbor, historic buildings, and scenic viewpoints overlooking Prince William Sound. Time is provided for lunch before transferring to the pier to embark on your Alaska cruise in the evening.

Overnight: Norwegian Jade

Day 3: Cruise Hubbard Glacier: Today will be spent onboard as we cruise Hubbard Glacier. The Hubbard Glacier is the largest tidewater glacier in North America. Its awe-inspiring, turquoise-colored face towers nearly 400 feet tall, 250 feet of which are underwater, while its icebergs are often three or four stories high. At nearly six miles wide where the ice meets the ocean and 76 miles long, viewing this massive glacial mass is an experience not soon forgotten. As you cruise near the glacier, keep an eye out for the region's rich variety of wildlife, from bald eagles to harbor seals, orcas and humpback whales.

Overnight: Norwegian Jade

Day 4: Glacier Bay & Icy Strait Point: Today the ship cruises through Glacier Bay National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its dramatic glaciers, snowcapped mountains, and pristine wilderness. From onboard, enjoy panoramic views of massive glaciers, icy fjords, and abundant wildlife as the ship slowly navigates this protected area. Later in the day, arrive in Icy Strait Point, where you will disembark the ship and enjoy free time to explore at your own pace. This area offers opportunities to experience Alaska's natural beauty, coastal scenery, and local culture. Optional shore excursions are available through the cruise line.

Overnight: Norwegian Jade

Day 5: Juneau: This morning we arrive in Juneau, the capital of Alaska, accessible only by air or sea. Time is available to explore the historic downtown area, browse local shops, or visit museums highlighting Alaska's history and native heritage. Optional excursions may include glacier viewing, whale watching, or scenic transportation offering panoramic views of the surrounding mountains and waterways.

Overnight: Norwegian Jade

Day 6: Skagway: Today we dock in Skagway, a charming town that preserves the spirit of the Klondike Gold Rush. Stroll along historic streets lined with restored buildings, visit local shops, or learn about the area's role in Alaska's early

history. Optional excursions may include scenic railway journeys, mountain drives, or guided historical tours.

Overnight: Norwegian Jade

Day 7: Ketchikan (Ward Cove): Arrive in Ketchikan, often referred to as Alaska's "First City." Known for its rich Native Alaskan culture and scenic waterfront, the town offers opportunities to view traditional totem poles, explore the historic Creek Street area, or enjoy local arts and crafts. Time is available to explore at your own pace or participate in optional activities.

Day 8: Cruise Inside Passage AL: Cruising through the Alaskan Inside Passage is a breathtaking experience that immerses you in the raw, untouched beauty of nature. As you glide through calm waters flanked by towering, snow-capped mountains and dense evergreen forests, you'll witness a symphony of wildlife, from majestic whales breaching in the distance to playful seals basking on rocky shores. Glaciers gleam like diamonds in the sunlight, their icy blue hues contrasting with the lush greenery of the surrounding landscape. Each turn reveals a new marvel, whether it's a cascading waterfall tumbling down rugged cliffs or a bald eagle soaring overhead. The serene atmosphere and pristine wilderness create a sense of awe and tranquility, making every moment spent cruising through the Alaskan Inside Passage an unforgettable adventure.

Day 9: Disembark Vancouver & Victoria: Today we disembark our ship in Vancouver. After we disembark, we drive to Victoria Island where we visit Butchart Gardens. Terms & Conditions

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot

guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 20.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.

VISAS: When and if a visa or visa waiver is required, it is the passenger's responsibility to obtain one. PVTT, owner, agent, or employees cannot be held liable for clients not having proper passports, visa, visa waiver, or other travel documents. Cancellations or changes to schedule due to a lack of appropriate documents will incur usual penalties.

PASSPORTS: Passports are required to travel with Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. A Passport Card is not useful for International Air Travel. Attempting to use this instead of a Passport Book will result in a denial of boarding by the airlines and entry by the legal authorities.

PHOTO RELEASE: Photos taken on the pilgrimage may be used to advertise for future pilgrimages. By registering for the tour, you consent to photographs taken of you during your participation in the tour and to the publication of the photographs by the Operator for advertising, promotional, and marketing purposes. VISA FOR EUROPE – ETIAS -Starting in 2025, Americans, Canadians, Australians will need to apply online for travel authorization for Europe. – This applies to all travelers, and all ages. – Fee approx. \$9 per person – The program is called ETIAS. Some refer to it as a "visa for Europe". It is not a traditional visa but needs basic details about the traveler and their trip.
