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Itinerario día a día

Día 1: Salida desde EE. UU: Su peregrinaje comienza hoy, al partir en su vuelo hacia Barcelona.

Día 2: Llegada a Barcelona: A nuestra llegada a Barcelona, seremos recibidos por nuestro representante y trasladados a nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Alojamiento: Barcelona (Cena*)

Día 3: Barcelona: Esta mañana visitaremos la iglesia más famosa la Sagrada Familia: La Sagrada Familia es una basílica católica situada en Barcelona, diseñada por el célebre arquitecto modernista Antoni Gaudí. Disfrutaremos de una visita guiada completa por la basílica antes de celebrar la Misa. A continuación, nos dirigiremos al Parque Güell antes de regresar a nuestro hotel para cenar y pasar la noche.

Alojamiento: Barcelona (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 4: Montserrat: Esta mañana nos trasladaremos a las afueras de Barcelona para visitar el Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Montserrat, el corazón espiritual de Cataluña y hogar de un monasterio benedictino situado en un entorno espectacular. Desde hace 700 años, este santuario mariano ha atraído a miles de peregrinos de todo el mundo. Haremos una parada aquí para visitar a la Virgen Morena de Montserrat, probablemente la devoción más ferviente a la Santísima Madre en toda España. Continuaremos hacia Andorra la Vella para cenar y descansar.

Alojamiento: Andorra la Vella (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 5: Andorra la Vella / Lourdes: Esta mañana, en Andorra la Vella, contemplaremos las iglesias románicas y las casas de piedra del casco urbano, además de visitar el Santuario de Nuestra Señora de Meritxell. Continuaremos hacia Lourdes, donde nos alojaremos en nuestro hotel.

Alojamiento: Lourdes (Desayuno, Cena).

Día 6: en Lourdes: Gruta de Massabielle, Basílica de San Pío X, Las Piscinas: Este día comenzamos con la Santa Misa en la Gruta de Massabielle, donde Nuestra Señora se apareció a Bernadette en 1858. Posteriormente, nos tomaremos nuestra foto oficial de grupo frente a la Basílica, seguida de nuestra visita guiada por Lourdes. Visitaremos el santuario de la Basílica de San Pío X, la iglesia subterránea más grande del mundo, así como la Basílica y las Piscinas, lugares donde han tenido lugar miles de curaciones milagrosas; este es el santuario y recinto de peregrinación más venerado de Francia.

Alojamiento: Lourdes (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 7: Lourdes: Día libre: Hoy dispondrá de un día libre en Lourdes para explorar este renombrado santuario mariano a su propio ritmo. Los peregrinos podrán dedicar tiempo a la oración en la Gruta de Massabielle —donde la Santísima Virgen María se apareció a Santa Bernadette en 1858—, visitar la Basílica de la Inmaculada Concepción y la Basílica de Nuestra Señora del Rosario, o participar en devociones personales por los jardines del santuario. Muchos peregrinos también dedican tiempo a rezar el Vía Crucis o a recoger agua del manantial milagroso.

Alojamiento: Lourdes (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 8: Lourdes / Loyola / Santander: Montes Pirineos, Basílica de Loyola: Esta mañana partimos de Lourdes y viajamos a través de los Montes Pirineos hacia Loyola, la ciudad natal de San Ignacio de Loyola, fundador de los jesuitas. Aquí visitarán la Basílica y la casa-torre donde nació y vivió. Continuamos hacia Santander para cenar y pernoctar.

Alojamiento: Santander (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 9: Oviedo / Santiago de Compostela: Catedral de Oviedo, Tumbas de los Reyes Asturianos, Cámara Santa. Partiremos de Santander esta mañana y nos dirigiremos a Oviedo, la capital de la región de Asturias. Aquí visitaremos la Catedral, que alberga las tumbas de los reyes asturianos, así como la Cámara Santa, una capilla restaurada del siglo IX que contiene expresivas estatuas de Cristo y los Apóstoles. A continuación, nos dirigiremos a Santiago de Compostela para cenar y pasar la noche.

Alojamiento: Santiago de Compostela (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 10: Santiago de Compostela: Catedral de Santiago de Compostela, Cripta de Santiago, Visita a la ciudad: Esta mañana comenzamos nuestra visita a Santiago de Compostela, uno de los santuarios más famosos del mundo, donde se descubrió la tumba de Santiago (hermano de San Juan). A Santiago se le encomendó la tarea de difundir el cristianismo en las lejanas tierras hispánicas y es conocido como el primer peregrino. Desde el descubrimiento de la tumba, han tenido lugar aquí numerosos milagros y, cada año, miles de fieles se reúnen el 25 de julio para celebrar su festividad. Comenzamos con una visita a la Catedral de Santiago, uno de los ejemplos arquitectónicos más destacados de toda Europa. Como peregrinos, tenemos la oportunidad de subir las escaleras situadas detrás del altar mayor para visitar la cripta donde se conservan las reliquias de Santiago, tocar el pilar central (Pórtico de la Gloria), contemplar el «Botafumeiro» y admirar la riqueza del arte medieval en el interior de la Catedral, antes de visitar el museo del claustro. Disfrute de un paseo por su cuenta a través de las hermosas calles de Santiago de Compostela, la ciudad del Apóstol, repleta de edificios históricos y otros lugares de interés. Cena y alojamiento en Santiago de Compostela.

Visita guiada a pie opcional por la mañana - Esta mañana salimos para unirnos a los peregrinos a pie en el Monte del Gozo, desde donde se divisan por primera vez las torres de la Catedral. Recorreremos las últimas millas de «El Camino» hasta llegar a la Catedral de Santiago, el destino que tanto hemos anhelado alcanzar. Continuaremos hacia el museo del claustro junto con nuestro grupo.

Alojamiento: Santiago de Compostela (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 11: Santiago de Compostela / Oporto / Fátima: Iglesia de San Francisco: Hoy partimos de Santiago de Compostela y continuamos hacia Oporto para visitar una bodega y disfrutar de una degustación de los mejores vinos. Visitamos la Iglesia de San Francisco antes de trasladarnos a Fátima para cenar y pasar la noche.

Alojamiento: Fátima (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 12: Fátima: Rosario y procesión de las velas. Esta mañana visitamos Fátima, donde Nuestra Santísima Madre se apareció a tres pastorcitos, Lucía Santos y sus primos, los beatos Jacinta y Francisco Marto, en 1917. Participamos en el Rosario y en la procesión de las velas.

Alojamiento: Fátima (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 13: Santarém / Lisboa: Tras el desayuno, partimos de Fátima y emprendemos el viaje hacia Lisboa, realizando una significativa parada en Santarém, una de las ciudades más antiguas de Portugal y sede del Milagro Eucarístico del siglo XIII. Visitamos la Iglesia de San Esteban (Santo Estêvão), donde se conserva y venera la Hostia milagrosa, reconocida como un auténtico milagro eucarístico. Disponemos de tiempo para la oración y la reflexión en este lugar sagrado, lo que ofrece un momento sagrado para profundizar nuestra devoción a la Presencia Real de Cristo en la Eucaristía. Concluida nuestra visita, continuamos hacia Lisboa, la hermosa capital de Portugal. A nuestra llegada, disfrutamos de tiempo libre para el almuerzo y del resto del día a nuestra entera disposición. Los peregrinos podrán explorar sus encantadoras calles, realizar compras de última hora o relajarse mientras se empapan de la rica cultura e historia de esta vibrante ciudad.

Alojamiento: Lisboa (Desayuno, Cena)

Día 14: Regreso a casa. Hoy nos despedimos de Portugal y embarcamos en nuestros vuelos de regreso, llevándonos con nosotros recuerdos que durarán toda la vida.

Below are the general terms & conditions. Dates and fees may change from tour to tour. For tour-specific information please refer to the terms and conditions on the travel brochure specific to your tour.

By making any payments (cash, credit card or otherwise) towards any tour constitutes your unconditional acceptance of all the terms and conditions stated in this brochure. Pax Via Tours & Travel Inc. shall be referred to as PVTT within this document.

DOCUMENTS: US citizens require a valid passport. Other nationalities please inquire with the appropriate embassies.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSIT: Deposit of \$500 per person is required upon registration along with a signed copy of the registration form. Registrations are processed in the order received by PVTT. Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Late payments are subject to a \$50 late fee per week past the due date. PVTT reserves the right to cancel reservations whose payments are 30 days late and to apply applicable cancellation/penalties indicated below. No registrations can be made over the telephone.

INDIVIDUAL CANCELLATION FEES & REFUNDS: Upon cancellation of participation of tour by you, the registrant, for any reason, and only after PVTT receives your written cancellation via email used to register or by US mail, PVTT will then refund your payment for services not received by you, minus applicable cancellation fees per person, according to the following schedule: All refunds will be processed via check. Credit card fees are collected by the payment processor and will not be refunded.

Minimum cancellation fee is \$500 from time of registration up to 120 days prior to the tour's departure date.

From 119 to 60 days prior to departure day, the cancellation fee is \$500 + 20% of total price.

From 59 days to 31 days prior to departure day, cancellation fee is \$500 + 50% of total price.

From 30 days prior to departure day onward, no refund is possible.

PAYMENT: Advertised price is the cash/check discounted price. If paying with a card, a processing fee will apply. Card processing fee is nonrefundable.

BOUNCED CHECKS: Bounced checks will incur a \$25 administrative fee.

DISPUTED PAYMENTS: In the event of a disputed payment for reasons other than a fraudulent charge, the administrative fees associated with a dispute will be invoiced to your account and either deducted from your refund or invoiced to you. These fees are subject to change due to payment processors' rules and regulations.

TRAVEL PROTECTION: Travel insurance is recommended to help protect you and your trip investment against the unexpected. For your convenience, we offer travel protection. If you do not wish to purchase now, the plan can be purchased any time before submitting your final payment. Coverage takes effect once payment is received. If you choose to purchase outside of the time-sensitive period outlined in the plan, you will not be eligible for time-sensitive benefits. All plan premiums are non-refundable. MEDICAL CONDITION: We endeavor to provide the highest level of service to all our passengers. Participants who require special assistance must be accompanied by a qualified helper who assumes total responsibility for the participants' well-being. This pilgrimage demands a lot of walking and can be strenuous. PVTT is not responsible for any medical conditions that occur prior to, during, or after the tour.

LAND TRANSPORTATION AND TRANSFERS: By private deluxe motor coach.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Tour prices are per person, based on two persons sharing double or twin-bedded rooms with a private bathroom with tub or shower. In the event that one does not sign up with a roommate and is not able to be paired with another traveler, there will be a single supplement charge to the account. Single rooms subject to availability and an additional cost indicated on the brochure. Accommodations are subject to change due to upgrade, size of group, etc.

MOBILE APP: Final pilgrimage details will be available through an app before departure. Please be aware that the information on the app is regularly updated and subject to change. PVTT holds no liability for errors or discrepancies in the app's content.

MEALS: Meals in accordance with the itinerary. All beverages are extra.

TIPPING: Unless it is specified in the tour brochure, the price of the tour does not include tips and gratuities. Tipping is recommended to the tour guide and motor coach driver approximately \$6 and \$4 per person, respectively, per day to each. Hotel tips are approximately \$2 per day per person. Tips may be pre-collected before the pilgrimage for your convenience.

AIRLINE TICKETS AND ITINERARY LENGTH: Air transportation to/from your destination will be economy class aboard carriers utilizing non-refundable, non-amenable tickets. Preliminary international flight schedules are available 60 days prior to departure and may change before they are finalized. Therefore, if you book the domestic flight on your own, you will be responsible for changing your domestic flights and incurring any change fees that would be generated by this adjustment. We are not responsible for changes and delays in airline schedules and do not reimburse passengers for expenses resulting from such occurrences. Travelers making their own flight arrangements should not purchase non-refundable, non-changeable tickets. We cannot

guarantee the most direct routing to your final destination. If flight schedules change, we reserve the right to lengthen or shorten the itinerary accordingly, and if changes or flight schedules necessitate extra overnights, you will be charged at normal hotel rates. Land Only packages do not include airport-hotel transfers.

SEAT ASSIGNMENT: THERE IS NO ADVANCE SEAT SELECTION FOR TOUR DEPARTURES. PVTT cannot guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline and are pending availability. When PVTT disperses travel packages, you will receive your record locator. You can use this locator to do online seating arrangements, if permitted by the airline. Any additional costs for seat selection are your responsibility. If your airline ticket is canceled for any reason, you must directly contact the airline to request a refund for your seat selection. The refund will be processed to your original form of payment, subject to the airline's terms and conditions.

BAGGAGE: Transatlantic and transpacific flights to and from the USA allow the passenger to bring one (1) checked bag, which may have a maximum weight of 50 lbs., and maximum combined dimensions of 62 inches. Also, one (1) "carry-on" with maximum dimensions of 8"x12"x20" is permitted. Luggage on domestic flights including Mexico & Canada will cost extra. Luggage is the passenger's responsibility and that of the airlines. For lost luggage, the passenger is responsible for notifying the airline directly. Check with your carrier regarding carry-on luggage rules and regulations. **PRICES:** All prices are based on exchange rates and fares applicable at the time of quotation and based on the minimum number of paying passengers stated in the brochure and are therefore subject to change if fares change (including fuel surcharges increase), if the group does not reach the minimum or if exchange rates fluctuate. Minimum number of paying passengers is 30.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport and Visas, exit taxes, meals not mentioned, beverages with meals, extras beyond the standard menu, excess baggage, luggage on domestic flights, telephone calls, fuel surcharges increase.
